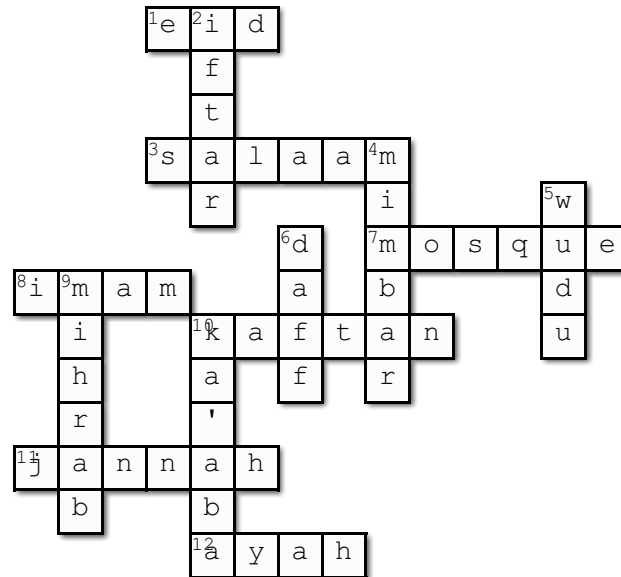


Crescent Moons and Pointed Minarets

1. An Islamic holiday. Eid ul-Fitr marks the end of Ramadan. (**eid**)
3. A greeting that means 'peace' in Arabic, often used as a hello or a goodbye (**salaam**)
7. A place where Muslims gather to remember, worship, and celebrate God, as well as hold community events (**mosque**)
8. A community member who leads prayer, and teaches Muslim tradition and heritage, usually in a Mosque (**imam**)
10. A long dress, worn in parts of the Middle East including Morocco & Tunisia. (**kaftan**)
11. The Garden of Paradise, or heavenly abode. (**jannah**)
12. A verse from the Holy Quran. A book that guides Muslims (**ayah**)

2. A light meal eaten at sunset upon completing a fast during the holy month of Ramadan (**iftar**)
4. A platform, or pulpit in a mosque where the Imam stands to deliver a sermon before prayers. (**mimbar**)
5. A ritual washing of the hands, arms, face, head, and feet before prayer (**wudu**)
6. A large frame drum used in the Near East & Central Asia (**daff**)
9. A niche or wall in most mosque that indicates the direction of Mecca and is often beautifully decorated (**mihrab**)
10. A holy temple in the city of Mecca, the word Ka'aba in Arabic means cube. (**ka'aba**)
